Team Composition

Team squads must have a minimum of [4] and a maximum of [8] players.

Teams can start between [4] and [6] players in a match line up, with a total of [2] substitutions available.

Team match line-ups are 'salary-capped', whereby:

- Pro Master - 5 points
- Pro - 4 points
- Semi Pro - 3 points
- Amateur - 2 points
- Beginner/unranked - 1 point

Points are determined by each player's BFA rating at their time of entry into the league. The latest BFA ratings can be found here: <https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/18sk2UDn5zMCvSgl4fhj32SeBw8xF1epB/edit#gid=987133997>

Ratings used in the 2022/23 regular season apply for the finals.

The 'salary-cap' for the match is determined by the number of starting players as follows:

- 4 players: 14 points
- 5 players: 16 points
- 6 players: 18 points

When making a substitution, the team line up salary-cap still applies i.e., a team cannot make a substitution if the salary cap would be breached as a result of the substitution.

Match Procedure & Format [Regular League Season]

Match Procedure:

The away team gets the choice of which side of the table to play on for the duration of the match.

If the match is played on a coin-operated table, the home team pays for the matches.

At the start of the first set a coin is flipped to decide which team starts with the ball. Thereafter, the team that kicks off alternates with each set.

Match Format:

Each team can field between [4] and [6] players at the start of each match.

Up to [2] substitutions can be made in the match. Substitutions can be made between sections. Once a player is substituted, they cannot re-enter the match.

Each match consists of [14] sets. Each set is a race to [5] goals. If a set is level at 4-4, play continues into overtime until there is a [2] goal difference, up to a ceiling of [8] goals (8-7 is a win).

Each team is allowed [1] time-out per set with an additional [1] time-out each in overtime.

The winner of the match is determined by the team with the most set victories.

Match Order:

The match order is as shown below. D represents Doubles, S represents Singles. Each player can only play once per section.

Each team can start between [4] and [6] players
Up to [2] substitutions can be made in the match

A player can only play once per section

Away team has the choice of side of the table for the duration of the match
Home team pays for the matches if on a coin-operated table
At the start of the first set a coin is tossed to determine kick off
Thereafter kick off alternates each set

Match Procedure & Format [Playoffs]

Match Procedure

Coin flip: To determine which side of both tables the teams will play on.

Starting serve: The team playing on the away table starts with the first serve.

Match Format

Each team can field between [4] and [6] players at the start of each match.

Up to [2] substitutions can be made in the match. Substitutions can be made between sections. Once a player is substituted, they cannot re-enter the match.

Each match consists of [14] sets. Each set is a race to [5] goals. If a set is level at 4-4, play continues into overtime until there is a [2] goal difference, up to a ceiling of [8] goals (8-7 is a win).

Each team is allowed [1] time-out per set with an additional [1] time-out each in overtime.

Teams will play [1] set on their home table, and [1] set on their opponent's table.

The winner of the match is determined by the team with the most set victories.

Match Order

The match order is as shown below. D represents Doubles, S represents Singles. Each player can only play once per section. Each set is played twice, once on each table, for [14] sets total.

Penalties

In the event of a 7-7 draw, the match is decided on penalties, with [4] penalty takers designated by each team (P1, P2, P3, P4). Each player will shoot and defend on both tables. If the teams are still level at the end of P4, sudden death penalties will take place, starting from P1 until there is a winner. In sudden death, each player must shoot and defend on each table before the result is decided.

A penalty is a shot from the 3 bar with the ball beginning on the 3 bar. The shooting player must initiate the standard ready protocol before taking the shot.

Match procedure
Coin flip 1: To determine which side of both tables the teams will play on Coin flip 2: To determine which table D1 vs D1 will begin on. D2 vs D2 will begin on the other table Starting serve: The team playing on the away table starts with the first serve
Penalties
[4] players selected from those <u>currently playing</u> in the match are designated by each team (P1, P2, P3, P4) Each player will shoot and defend on both tables If teams are level at the end of P4, sudden death will take place, starting from P1 until there is a winner In sudden death, both players must shoot and defend on each table before the result is decided Coin flip to decide which team shoots first or which table to start on
