



Important Information

Player Licence

- UK residents must have a British Foosball Association (BFA) Class A Player Licence to enter ITSF events (Open, Women's, O50, U19, Mixed). A Class B licence is required to enter Masters, Semi-Pro and Amateur events. No licence is required for the Monster DYPs.
- If you need a licence, or need to upgrade your existing licence, please contact your club leader, or the BFA by emailing contact@britfoos.com
- Players residing overseas must have an ITSF licence issued by their national federation.

Capacity Limit

This tournament will be run on 13-20 ITSF Tornado tables. To ensure the smooth running of this
tournament, each event is limited by capacity. If we are able to add more tables (we are trying) we
will increase the capacity and announce this online.

Registration

- Purchase your event tickets at www.londontablefootball.com.
- Once you have purchased your tickets, we will register you for the tournament in the ITSF tournament software Coral (app.tablesoccer.org/) and you will be able to view your registration. You will need an active account in Coral - if you do not have one please create one otherwise we cannot register you. Registration closes Friday September 26th at 23:59.
- There is no registration or organisation fee for this tournament.

Tournament Prize Fund

- Prize Fund = tournament revenue cost of running the tournament.
- We project there will be approximately £1,500-2,500 in the Prize Fund.
- Prize Fund allocation for each event is calculated proportionate to the revenue generated by said event, i.e. the more money going into an event, the more money paid out in the event.
- Prize Fund breakdown per finishing position is determined by number of attendees per event, details of which can be found in the BFA Tournament Regulations Policy document https://britfoos.com/wp-content/uploads/2023/01/Tournament-Regulations.pdf

Important Information

Event Exclusivity

- Women must choose between Women's or Open events.
- Players must choose between Masters or Semi-Pro Doubles.
- Eligible players must choose between Semi Pro Singles and Amateur Singles

Event Eligibility

- Over 50 Singles/Doubles: Only players aged 50 or over
- U19 Singles/Doubles: Only players aged under 19
- Semi Pro Singles/Doubles: Only players rated Semi-Pro, Amateur, Beginner or unrated
- Amateur Singles/Doubles: Only players rated Amateur, Beginner or unrated

All international non-UK resident players are rated Pro and are not eligible for Semi-Pro or Amateur events.

Seeding

- The ITSF events will be seeded according to ITSF ranking.
- Seeds are protected for the first round of qualification in ITSF events.

Miscellaneous

- All matches must be played with Tornado balls. Balls (and wraps) can be purchased at the tournament.
- ITSF Rules will be applied, including ITSF sweatball rules for all ITSF events.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter event formats.
- We will operate standard ITSF recall procedure for all matches.
- The BFA Code Of Conduct will be in force.

Event Cancellation

 If fewer than 4 players/teams register for an event the event won't take place and refunds will be issued.
